



Land Use in Hungary, 2011



- EU DP eligible area: 4.96 million hectares (-0.8% over 2004)
- EU DP beneficiaries: 176.3 thousand (-15.5% over 2004)
- Average farm size: 28.1 hectares (+17.1% over 2004)
- Around 600 DP beneficiaries getting 25% of the area payments and 33% of the livestock aids

AG Census 2010

- Private holdings: 566.7 thousand (-40.9% over 2000)
- Legal entities: 8.8 thousand (+4.8% over 2000)
 - Tax paying farms: 81.9 thousand
 - Farm managers over 55 years of age: 43%
 - Farmers using UAA with an AG education: 43%

- Total UAA: 5.34 million hectares
- Irrigated area: 79.4 thousand hectares (-31.4% over 2000)
- Protected area: 3.9 thousand hectares (-37.1% over 2000)







The Share of Agriculture and Food Industry in the GDP, Employment, and Investment in Hungary




Share of Crop and Livestock Sectors in the Value of Crop Production and Livestock Farming in Hungary









'Black' and 'Grey' Economy

- 20 to 30 % in most agricultural branches and in the downstream industries
- Tax burdens are relatively high, legal security is weak, unemployment is widespread
- Lack of transparency in the taxation system corrupts above all the tax morality of smaller enterprises, and forces larger processors into the 'grey zone'
- **⇒** Tax avoidance
 - Ø integration
 - Ø concentration
 - Ø market transparency
 - Ø efficient representation and assertion of interests
